

Sabbatical What Is Going to Happen?

As my sabbatical rapidly approaches, the questions about "what is going to happen?" are increasing. The answer to the question is two-fold; we have a plan for what is going to happen at Ascension while I am gone and I am working on a plan for my time away.

When is my sabbatical? August 4, through October 26, 2025. Sunday, August 3rd will be my last Sunday and Monday, October 27th will be my first day back in the office.

What will happen at Ascension during my sabbatical? Pr. Bruce will work approximately 15 hours a week during which he will focus upon: providing support to the Care Team in providing pastoral care to the congregation; providing support to the church staff during the week; providing leadership in worship each Sunday; providing a pastoral and theological perspective to the Church Council and congregation. Andrea and guest preachers will fill the pulpit for the 12 Sundays that I am away.

The Church Council will continue to work together and with the congregation to provide leadership and support for the ministries and projects that the congregation is already engaged in, or decides to begin, during my sabbatical. The plan is to NOT have everything planned before I leave for sabbatical, but to encourage the congregation to plan and implement the ministries and projects that have Council and congregational support. Which means that some things that have happened in the past, might not happen and new things might begin. Our time apart should provide new opportunities, new energy and new life.

I have a number of trips planned for my time away; a week in Kauai with Robin and our granddaughter, Phoenix, a week in New York to visit our daughter and son in law, a week in Cabo with a couple of long-time friends, the time in Spain walking the Camino de Santiago with my brother, and three weeks in Santa Cruz, waking to the sound of the waves of the ocean. Robin and I will take a few weekend trips, which we are rarely able to do, and there will be projects and much reading to be done while I am home and Robin is working.

I am exceedingly grateful for the gift of both time and resources that will allow me to have my first sabbatical. I pray that the time is fruitful for each of our ministries. Thanks to Pr. Bruce and the Council for the many ways that you have and will step in to make my sabbatical possible.


President's Ponderings




